Rick Anderson grew up in the west, living in California, Texas, and Wyoming. He graduated from the University of Wyoming with a degree in Mechanical Engineering and then attended the University of Notre Dame Law School, graduating in 1976. It was while practicing law in Wyoming that he was saved by God's grace. Rick was involved in a private practice and then as a criminal prosecutor for 10 years. In 1987 he began attending the Master's Seminary and upon graduation was called to Faith Community Church. Rick has been pastoring at Faith Community since 1989. He is married to Penny and has three married daughters and five grandchildren.



Dr. Michael A.G. Haykin is currently the Director of The Andrew Fuller Center for Baptist Studies, located on the campus of The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary. He is also Professor of Church History and Biblical Spirituality at Southern Baptist Theological Seminary and the editor of *Eusebeia: The Bulletin of The Andrew Fuller Center for Baptist Studies*.

Dr. Haykin has a B.A. in Philosophy from the University of Toronto (1974), a M.Rel. from Wycliffe College, the University of Toronto (1977), and a Th.D. in Church History from the University of Toronto and Wycliffe College (1982). He is the author of a number of books and served as editor for *The Life and Thought of John Gill (1697-1771): A Tercentennial Appreciation* (E.J. Brill, 1997) and *The British Particular Baptists, 1638-1910. 3 Volumes* (Particular Baptist Press, 1998, 2000, 2003).



Jason Deutsch is a graduate of The Master's College and alum of both Denver Seminary and Cohen Theological Seminary where he attained his M.A./Biblical Studies and Th.M/Theological Studies before heeding the call to the mission field. Jason and his wife, Jemima, have planted six churches and have ministered arduously in desperate India for more than 15 years. Among the fruit of their labors there is Providence Evangelical Bible Seminary, a center for edification and teaching located in New Panvel, Navi

Mumbai, Maharashtra. Jason is a lover of the Lord, a devoted husband to Jemima, a proud dad to Darshini and Andrew, and a faithful pastor-elder to Trinity Baptist Church in Shreveport.



Martin Rizley has served as an elder at Texarkana Reformed Baptist Church (TRBC) since 2003. Martin grew up in Houston, Texas, having come to faith in Christ through the witness of high school friends. In 1983, Martin graduated with a bachelor's degree in English from Trinity University. From there he pursued studies at Reformed Theological Seminary in Jackson, Mississippi, graduating in 1988 with his Master of Divinity in Missions.

A few years later Martin moved to Spain, working almost three and a half years as a church-planting missionary with Worldwide Evangelization for Christ. Martin began working as a local church evangelist in Alcazar de San Jaun with the European Missionary Fellowship (EMF), wherein he met his wife, Paola Loreface, the daughter of Reformed Baptist missionaries in Sicily who were also working with EMF. Most recently, Martin has begun to preach the gospel weekly on the program "Grace Abounding," a radio ministry of TRBC.



Curt Arend has served the Lord as founding pastor of Grace Bible Church San Diego since April 2006. Prior to that, he served for six years as one of the pastors of Grace Bible Church in Escondido.

Curt was converted to Christ in the late 1980's and began sensing a call to Gospel ministry in 1994. Curt began devouring reformed literature and

Puritan works. He also has studied at length systematic theology, pastoral theology and homiletics. He completed a three year internship program at Grace Bible Church, Escondido, as well as three years of Greek.
